Job Description

Traffic Control Officers (TCO): non-sworn civilian personnel who are trained and are prepared to assist the Georgetown Police Department with traffic and pedestrian control functions. The specific limits, utilization, and level of training of the Traffic Control Officers (TCO) are left to the discretion of the Chief of Police. To be sufficiently prepared for traffic control, the training for the TCO must be consistent with their responsibilities and assigned duties. TCO's must demonstrate a firm commitment to carry out assignments in a competent, timely and professional manner. It is the policy of the Georgetown Police Department to provide guidance to TCO's through various policies, procedures, and regulations, which have been established to direct members in the performance of their duties and responsibilities.
