The Crossing Guard will report directly to the Chief of Police or their Designee.

Duties and Responsibilities

- **Pedestrian Safety:** Safely guide students and other pedestrians across designated crosswalks.
- **Traffic Awareness:** Monitor traffic conditions and ensure vehicles stop before pedestrians enter the roadway.
- **Community Interaction:** Maintain a courteous, professional presence while interacting with students, families, and motorists.
- **Incident Reporting:** Notify supervisors of any safety concerns, hazards, or incidents occurring during duty hours.

Operating Hours

- **Morning:** 7:00 AM – 9:00 AM
- **Afternoon:** 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM (*Hours may be adjusted based on school schedule.*)

- **Successful Completion of Background Examination**
- **Reliable Transportation**
- **Ability to Assist Pedestrians Safely in a Crosswalk**
